With this in mind I am presenting the annual report for the Academic Year 2021-22 which includes the ocean of activities our school has organized for the holistic development of students as well as teachers.

Academics

Rashtrottana Vidya Kendra, Arkavathy organized a virtual orientation programme for the parents of class 1- 5 on 12th June, 6-8 on 5th June and 9 & 10 on 28th May 2021. The focus of the session was to give the parents an overview about how the academic session 2021-22 is going to be conducted. Co- scholastic Activities

The physical education team too has played its role in keeping our students healthy and fit by engaging the students in outdoor and indoor activities.

The yoga department has played an important role by teaching the students various Asanas and the art of meditation which is very much essential during this stressful times of the pandemic.

The ID department too has played its role by involving the students in their field if interest be it tabla, keyboard, dance or drama.

Teacher's Augmentation Programmes

Keeping in mind the above our school always believes in grooming the teachers on regular basis because learning never stops,so it organises programmes to enhance the skills of the teachers.
