Professional Development of Educators

One of RVK's most distinguishing hallmarks is its unwavering, institutional commitment to the continuous professional growth of its teaching faculty. Teachers' Orientation Programme (TOP) — May & July 2025

36th Vidya Bharati National Swimming Championship — November 2025

RVK, Thanisandra, was supremely honoured to host the prestigious 36th Vidya Bharati National Swimming Championship from 14th to 16th November 2025. An extraordinary contingent of 156 skilled swimmers from across the nation converged upon this esteemed venue, and the Dakshina Madhya Kshetra team — representing our region — emerged as triumphant Overall Champions with a commanding 783 points, with Rajasthan as runner-up at 157 points.

Yoga Education — Holistic Well-being Through Ancient Wisdom

The Yoga Department of RVK Thanisandra continued its magnificent work of nurturing holistic well-being through the transformative science of yoga across all grade levels.
